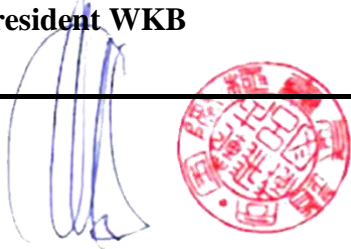

Regulations

for holding

The 3rd WKB World Championship

among Juniors, Youth, Adults, and Seniors in “Kumite” and “Kata” sections

Purpose and Tasks of the competition

The competition aims to:

- raise the level of health along with physical and spiritual development of the population;
- develop and popularize Kyokushin Karate in Ukraine and Europe;
- improve the practical experience of judges;
- set up good relationship between athletes of different federations and organizations of Ukraine, Europe and the World.

The time and place of the competition

1. The 3rd WKB World Championship will be held on **June 03-06 2022**.
2. The address: Ukraine, Kiev, Sport square 1, Palace of Sports
3. June 03.2022 – arrival day
June 06.2022 – departure day

The competition management and judging

1. The general management of organization and holding the competition is given to the Separated Unit of the Public Association ‘Ukrainian Association “Kyokushin Budo Karate” in Kiev.

2. Direct competition holding is assigned to Public Association “Ukrainian Association “Kyokushin Budo Karate” and the main panel of judges.
3. The Chief organizer – Hanshi Sergii Vsevolodov (7th Dan)
Supreme judge – Kancho Pedro Roiz (8th Dan)
4. The organization committee is not responsible for accidents or injuries happening during the competition.

Competition schedule

Participants

1. Any amount of athletes or members of Kyokushin Karate teams of any sports organizations (federations, associations, clubs etc.) can take part in the open competition, but the organization has the right to reject an application for the competition.

The participants must submit the following documents to the credentials committee:

- an application form for participation according to the established template (see Annex 2) with medical admission;
- birth certificate or passport;
- an application form with permission to take part in the competition signed by parents/ personal application form for participation in the competition for adults (see Annex 3);
- insurance policy.

Each team goes through credentials committee with the obligatory presence of all its athletes and a coach-representative.

2. Participants compete wearing white dogi uniform (registered members of WKB must not have any stamps related to other organizations on their dogi) and personal protective gear (in Kumite section) according to the current rules of Kyokushin Karate WKB in Ukraine:

Personal protective gear for

1) underaged participants:

- boys: headgear, shin and foot protection, groin protection, hands protection.
- girls: headgear, shin and foot protection, groin protection, hands protection, chest protector not covering solar plexus.

2) adult participants:

Male: groin protection.

Female: groin protection, chest protection not covering the solar plexus.

3) Seniors (male and female): shin and foot protection, groin protection, hands protection, chest protector not covering solar plexus (only female).

Participants without the personal protective gear are not allowed to take part in the competition!!

Rules of the competition

1. Kumite competitions will be held according to the rules of Kyokushin Karate WKB International Organization and according to the Olympic system.

2. Team structure: any number of participants in each weight category, 2 judges, 1 representative-are required.

4. In case of insufficient number of members according to the submitted applications, the Organizing Committee may make the following changes to the Regulations of the competitions:

- to combine some of the weight categories;
- to hold competitions in circular manner for certain weight categories.

Conditions for holding the competition

1. The competition will be held according to the present rules of Kyokushin Karate WKB in Ukraine.
2. A team score is common for male and female participants. In order to determine the places of teams for personal-team priority, the results of all participants will be taken into account. Team points are awarded according to the rules of Kyokushin karate WKB in Ukraine.

Awarding

1. Athletes who took 1-3 places are awarded with cups, diplomas and medals of the appropriate degrees.
2. The teams who took 1-3 places are awarded with the cup of the appropriate degrees.

Conditions for admission of participants. Financing

1. The following expenses are borne by the Public Association “Ukrainian Association “Kyokushin Budo Karate”, interested institutions, organizations and sponsors: rewards for participants of the competition; the rent of sports equipment and utility rooms; the place for holding the competition and office equipment; rent of tatami; payment for stationery, medications, medical staff and other staff; printing of posters, programs and other needed attributes; advertising; transport; other expenses for organizing and holding the competition.

2. All financial expenses for transferring participants, coaches and judges are paid by the sending organizations.

1. The application forms must be filled until **01.05.2022** according to the annex **№ 1**.
Additional information about the competition holding and online registration with the help of modern applications may be sent in future.

2. The drawing of lots will take place on preliminary requests on May 22nd 2022.

3. To pass the credentials committee each participant must have: parents' permission (for athletes under 18), passport or birth certificate, insurance policy and medical admission.

4. The fees for participating in the 3rd WKB World Championship in “Kumite” and “Kata” sections among juniors, youth, adults and seniors are:

5. Athletes perform wearing a clean white dogi with Kyokushin Karate symbols on it (no stamps related to other organizations are allowed on the registered WKB members' dogi), belt of an appropriate degree and personal protective gear. The degree of proficiency of participants should not be lower than **8th Kyu**.

6. Each team must provide two representatives for the refereeing (judging).
The uniform for judges: white shirt with short sleeves, dark blue tie, dark pants, personal whistle.
The absence of team representative for judgment makes it impossible for a representative of such team to complain about the competition organization or any decision made by organization committee.
Taking part in judging seminar before the competition is obligatory for all judges and team representatives. A special badge that allows the coach and team representatives to be on tatami with their athlete will be give **after** listening to the seminar.
